## Board of Education Meeting August 10, 2020

- Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.
- Open Meetings Act was announced and posted in the room.
- The agenda was approved as published.
- Minutes of the July 13, 2020 meeting were approved as printed.
- The next meeting of the Board of Education will be September 14, 2020 at 7:30 p.m.
- During public comments there was a discussion of Covid-19 issues.
- Counselor Theresa Schmedding presented her monthly report.
- Activity Director Tim Rossow was not present. Mr. Shalikow talked to Boone Central activity director Jon Perone. Activities are starting as planned, with certain Covid restrictions in place.
- Principal Erin Forre presented her report to the board.
- Superintendent Shalikow presented his report. He gave the August report of the Nebraska Liquid Asset Fund. Construction budget was discussed.
- Approved Pekny and Associates, CPA for this year's district Audit.
- Approved Student Assurance Services as additional insurance coverage for students and district.
- Approved the Title IX policy update.
- Approved Policy 2006 complaint procedure.
- Approved to remove Policy 5026-sex discrimination and sexual harassment of students policy (which is now combined in Policy 2006).
- Approved the purchase of tile for the 7-12 building.
- The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented; claims were approved for payment in the amounts of \$240,449.03 (General Fund), \$1,390.00 (Depreciation Fund), and \$501,614.15 (Building Fund).
- The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
